How it works...

Buy an instrument for your child without paying VAT!

Information...

If your child is learning to play a musical instrument at a State School or Academy, then you may be eligible to buy an instrument without paying the VAT – a considerable saving on the purchase of an expensive item. The Assisted Instrument Purchase Scheme (AIPS) is approved by HM Customs and Excise.

Your child's school or the LEA Music Service buy the instrument from the retailer and then sell it to you, without charging the VAT. Please note that an administration charge may be made by the Music Service or the School.

Who is eligible?

- Your child must be in full time education at a State School or Academy
- Your child must be learning to play an instrument at the School or Music Service
- The instrument must be portable and suitable for their needs and ability
- The instrument must be handed over at either the school or a place designated by the school or Music Service
